In Literacy we will be:

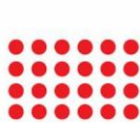
- Reading traditional tales (The Three Little Pigs) and writing an extended story inspired by it.
- Learning about The Great Fire of London and writing a newspaper report and a story from the perspective of Vlad the flea.
- Exploring a range of texts and developing our reading skills through reading practise sessions.
- Looking at performance poetry and writing a poem to perform.

In grammar we will be:

- Learning how to use coordinating and subordinating conjunctions to add detail to our sentences.
- Learning to write in the past tense.

In Numeracy we will be:

- Continuing to practise our 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables
- Using practical resources to multiply and divide
- Learning to multiply by drawing arrays
- Learning to divide by drawing groups of
- Recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes
- Finding fractions of shapes and quantities
- Counting in fractions
- Continue to improve our mental maths during fluency lessons

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International Primary Curriculum (IPC) Topic – Buildings

As part of our learning in Design Technology we will be:

As part of our learning in Geography we will be learning:

As part of our learning in Art we will be:

- Weaving using different materials.
- Printing our own IKAT designs using foam boards.

- About the different structures of tunes and songs
- Composing our own music
- Recording our own compositions on paper

Spring 2 Beginnings and Endings.

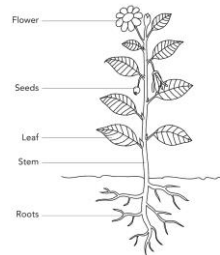
- We will be exploring how beginnings and endings are marked in special ways in different religions and our own lives.

- Developing our balance and coordination during speed stacking.

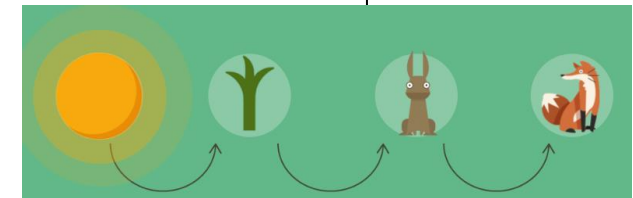
In Design Technology we will be learning:
