In Literacy we will be:

Writing to entertain

- Focusing on stories from other cultures and writing our own narrative texts.
- Writing diary entries.
- Writing information texts about Egyptians.
- Writing newspaper reports.
- Developing our handwriting and spelling skills as part of our general literacy session and through targeted lessons.
- Exploring a range of texts and developing our reading skills through text immersion sessions every week.
- Focusing on extending the range of sentences with more than one clause in our writing.
- Extending noun phrases to interest the reader.
- Using paragraphs in our writing.

In Numeracy we will be:

- Consolidating our place value knowledge.
- Developing mental skills to add and subtract numbers efficiently.
- Learning and using formal methods to add and subtract 3 digit numbers.
- Focusing on learning and quick recall of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Maths homework will be linked to the work children have been carrying out in class.

International Primary Curriculum (IPC) Topic - Temples, Tombs and Treasures

As part of our learning in Technology we'll be:

- Designing and making an Egyptian Headdress
- Making a 'Book of the Dead' container and scroll

As part of our learning in History we'll be:

- Finding out the Ancient Egyptian lifestyle and culture and what might have influenced them to settle in Egypt.
- Finding out about the Egyptian era and who the significant people were and the key events that happened.

As part of our learning in Science we'll be:

- Learning that light travels from a source and that objects form shadows when they block that passage of light.
- Understanding that sounds are made when objects vibrate.
- Learning to create sounds with a variety of objects and changing sounds by altering variables.

As part of our International learning we'll be:

- Finding out about what daily life is like in modern Egypt and what it would have been like in Ancient Egypt
- Finding out about food, weather, culture and the geographical location of Egypt. <u>As part of our learning in Music we'll be:</u>
 - Finding out about music from our host country: Egypt
 - Learning about different composition and creating our own piece of music

As part of our learning in Computing we'll be:

• Learning all about being online. Including online safety, online bullying, safe searching and copyright laws.

We will also be having steel pan tuition.

• Learning about musical notes, rhythm, beats and the origin of the instrument.
