

# Our Learning Journey in Yr2 – Spring 2021

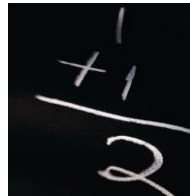
## In Literacy we will be:



- Reading traditional tales (The Three Little Pigs)
- Continuing to develop our decoding and comprehension skills
- Writing an extended story inspired by our key texts
- Learning about The Great Fire of London and recording our knowledge in a variety of ways
- Developing research skills using books and ICT
- Focusing on grammar and punctuation
- Exploring a range of texts and developing our reading skills through guided reading sessions.
- Writing for different purposes including; letters, newspaper reports and stories.

## In Numeracy we will be:

- Learning our 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Learning practical, pictorial and written strategies to help us add and subtract when crossing the 10
- Using practical resources to multiply and divide
- Learning to multiply by drawing arrays
- Learning to divide by drawing groups
- Recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes
- Finding fractions of shapes and quantities
- Counting in fractions
- Continue to improve our mental maths during fluency lessons



## International Primary Curriculum (IPC) Topic – Buildings

### As part of our learning in History we'll be:

- Learning how buildings were made in the past
- Creating a timeline of buildings
- Discussing how buildings have changed



### As part of our learning in International we'll be finding out:

- About the different houses people live in, in different countries
- Exploring what traditional houses are like in the countries we are from



### As part of our learning in Science we will be:

- Testing the strengths of structures
- Learning about the different materials used in structures



### As part of our learning in Geography we will be learning:

- About different houses, homes and other buildings around the world
- How to use maps and atlases to locate the different countries these buildings are in

### As part of our learning in Art we will be learning:

- Drawing pictures of local buildings
- Making and decorating models of buildings



### As part of our learning in Music we will be learning:

- About the different structures of tunes and songs
- Composing our own music
- Recording our own compositions on paper

- A focus on the England as our home country.

- A focus on Cambodia as our chosen host country.

### In Religious Education we will be:

Exploring the key questions:

### As part of our learning in Science – we'll be finding out:

- How we use different materials
- How to test materials

### In Design Technology we will:

- making models of houses
- creating applique houses



### In P.E we will be:

- Developing our hand eye coordination in archery
- Making different shapes with our bodies and developing our balance and coordination in dance
- Learning how to attack and defend in team sports (football and tag rugby)

### Help at Home
