


Enable parental controls It is recommended to download Google Family Link, if you want to monitor your child's smartphone activity, manage the apps they can use and download, set screen time limits, lock their device, and track their location.

To enable parental controls and set up Google Family Link. Swipe down from the top of the screen and tap the cog located top right to open the “Settings” menu. Scroll to “Digital Wellbeing and parental controls”.






-  Supervise this phone remotely with the Family Link app for parents


Tap “Child or teenager”.


Now time to link your child's Google account with your Google family group. If it's not the account list, add your child's Google account by choosing "Add or create account for your child" then tap "Next".


Review what you can and cannot do with Google Family Link with your child. Scroll to the bottom and enter the password of the child's account to continue. Tap "Agree", then tap "Allow supervision".

Next, you can manage what apps the user can and cannot access. Once approved tap “Next”.



Next, you can manage filters and settings, such as Google Play purchases, app, Games, Films, TV and Books via PEGI rating. Once approved tap “Next”.




Install Google Family Link You can then install the Google Family Link app which gives your child a dashboard of what activity a parent can see. You can install Google Family Link from the Google Play Store on their device to further manage your child's account and access it remotely. 



Enable Secret Mode Secret mode lets you browse in private without leaving any traces in your browsing history. Open Samsung Internet and tap the “Tabs” icon located either on the top or bottom of the display (depending on device screen size). Next, tap “Turn on Secret mode”.



- 11 Tap the toggle on “Lock Secret mode” button. Then enter a password – it must contain at least four character and one letter. Confirm the password again.

Keep your browsing private and safe.

Lock Secret mode

You can lock Secret mode with a password or biometrics to get the most protection. You can change this later in Secret mode settings.

Secret mode gives you the same browsing experience as you normally get in Samsung Internet, but with extra privacy protection. Cookies and browsing history for any websites you visit in Secret mode will be erased from your phone as soon as all of your Secret mode tabs are closed.

You can still save pages and bookmarks in Secret mode. These saved pages and bookmarks will only be visible in Secret mode.

Set password

Passwords must contain at least 4 characters, including at least 1 letter.
